In Phillipians 4:8, we read, *Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things. In these days of gloomy, sometimes distressing news, it's good to be reminded that we don't need to dwell on those things, but we can be looking for things that will help us to delight in a good Heavenly Father who has given us so much to enjoy.*
